

Westminster Park / USDGC Doubles

*Out of Bounds (OB) - OB lie plays from the last point in bounds

General Rules:

Gravel Road and beyond are out of bounds.

With exception of the water on the right side of Hole 4, all water at Westminster is casual water.

Relief is granted from casual water as outlined below in the PDGA rules.

806.03 Casual Area

A casual area is casual water, or any area specifically designated as a casual area by the Director before the round. Casual water is any body of water that is in-bounds and has not been explicitly declared by the Director to be in play.

To obtain relief from a casual area, the player's lie may be relocated without penalty to the nearest lie which is farther from the target and is on the line of play, at the nearest point that provides relief (unless greater casual relief is announced by the Director).

Hole Specific Rules:

Hole 2: The creek on the left of the green is a casual area. Player's lie may be relocated without penalty to the nearest lie which is farther from the target and is on the line of play, at the nearest point that provides relief (806.03)

Hole 4: Marsh (Water) on the right side of the fairway. If a disc that lands in the water is completely surrounded by water, then it is considered OB; whereas if any part of the disc is crossing over dry land, then it is considered safe.

Hole 7 - Please ignore the yellow painted line surrounding this hole. It is not in play.
